Dive Team

Hello prospective dive families!

We are excited for the dive season! We hope you will consider joining dive team and encourage you to register via bwh.swimtopia.com.

If you aren't sure whether or not your kid(s) may want to dive, don't hesitate to come try a few practices out just to see how they like it!

Dive Team: Diving is a great sport, especially for kids. It is a ton of fun and teaches you great lessons of discipline, confidence, overcoming fears, and teamwork. All of our coaches started very young and are experienced. We will keep your kid(s) safe and having fun all season! We want to win City Championships. We won in 2016 and were runners up for the last two years, losing by a single point last year.

Coach Drew Sheldon: Drew is a senior at NAHS and placed 1st in the 6A GHSA State dive meet the past two years. He has been diving at Brookwood Hills since he was six years old and competed with Atlanta Diving for seven years. This will be Drew's fifth year of coaching. He will attend Davidson College in the fall on a diving scholarship.

Coach Avery Fassnacht: Avery Fassnacht will be returning for her second season coaching. She is a sophomore at Whitefield Academy and dove with Atlanta Diving Association at Tech for eight years. She started diving at BWH at age eight and then at Atlanta Diving the next fall. Avery is an All American and finished 2nd in the 1-3A GHSA dive meet.

Practice Schedule: Our meet schedule has not been released yet, but we assume our first meet will be May 29, so our **first practice will be on Monday, May 6th and will be from 4-6pm Monday-Thursday from May 6th-24th**. Once schools are out, we will change to our summer practice schedule: **Monday-Thursday 3-5pm, Monday & Wednesday**

we will have an additional morning practice from 9-11am, and Fridays are 10am-12. There are no age group specific times. We suggest divers come at least once a day for 30-45 minutes, which can be before or after swim practice (or both!).

Meets: Wednesday evenings in June. Usually warm ups start around 4pm and the whole meet is usually over by 8 or 9pm. They run in age group order, starting with 6&U, so younger divers finish earlier. We usually have five meets and City Championships.

Attendance: Summer is a busy time, but we ask that you plan to be in town and participating in practices/meets as often as possible! We need **EVERY DIVER** at every meet, both home and away! Please let coaches know asap if you can't attend; texting is fine.

Fellinis (Howell Mill): It has been a BWH Dive Team tradition for parents and divers to go the Fellini's after every meet.

Meet and Greet: We hope to also see everyone at the meet and greet on April 28th at the BWH pavilion from 1-3pm.
