





June 17-21 10 AM-11 AM


9 and 10 year olds:

11 and 12 year olds:


July 1-5 9 AM—10 AM

Plus we had a team leader/project superintendent who could handle all the dynamics of the project (which is something like staging "A Midsummer Night's Dream" and "The Tempest" at the same time) and bring us in on time. That person is Jay Blasingame and we are blessed to have him with us.

It's been an interesting and exciting journey (lifting 1000 pound beams two stories, mostly with manpower) and as it draws to a close, I would like to thank Silverman Construction for getting us involved, Norman Askins for a great design, John Bencich for wonderful architectural details, Carolynn Cooper, Clark Landers, Sarah Armstrong, and the rest of the board and community for allowing us the opportunity to create this beautiful park.


