The 2018 Bullfrogs Swim and Dive Season is Almost Here

The 2018 BWH Swim and Dive season is just around the corner! We are super excited to see many returning swimmers and hope to see lots of new faces this year.

Registration is now open and continues through April 13th. Registrations after that day will incur a late fee from ASA. To register please go to our new website **bwh.swimtopia.com** and click on the "register now" button. The process is very simple. Please note that this is a new website and our old one is no longer active. You will find lots of information on the site but don't hesitate to reach out to one of the swim team chairs if you have any questions.

We will also be having our Jr. Frogs program this Summer. The Jr. Frogs Program is designed to help younger children learn to swim the full length of the pool and transition onto the swim team. The fee is \$100/week (M-Th) for 30 minutes of instruction per day (11:00-11:30 am each day) and the program starts June 4th. If you are interested in this program please meet the coaches by the scoreboard at the pool at 11:00 am on June 4th, June 11th, and/or June 18th (you don't have to swim every week although that is an option).

Dear Fellow Brookwood Hills Neighbors,

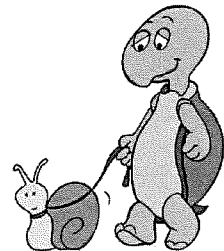
The BWH Board has created a Safety Committee under Security Chair, Matt Little. The main purpose of the Committee is to address habitual unsafe driving on our neighborhood streets and to identify and correct any safety hazards that may arise.

You received a survey in December to determine the current state of safety and security in Brookwood Hills. The majority of respondents felt that speeding and unsafe driving were problems. In response to these concerns, we are looking at several different traffic calming measures to tackle unsafe driving and are using the survey results to guide our decision making.

We want to make pedestrian safety a priority, making sure our streets are safe for all our neighbors -- from young children to adults enjoying their retirement.

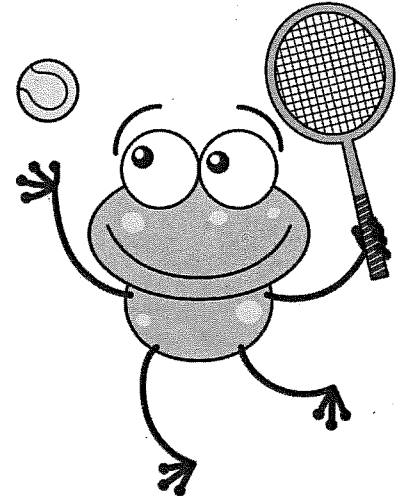

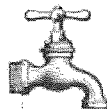

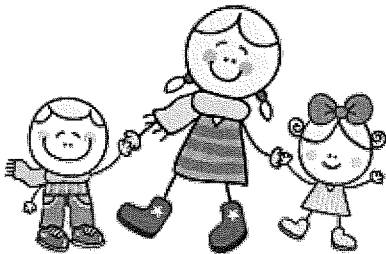
CHOA Friends Corner

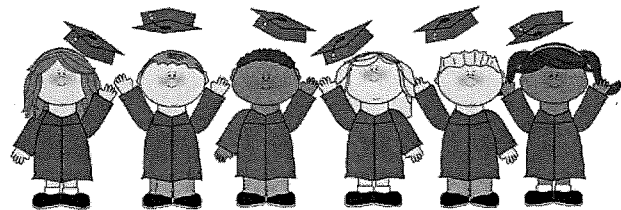
