Pike's Gift Cards Benefit Children's Healthcare of Atlanta

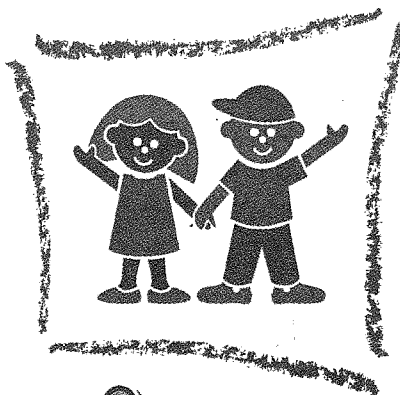

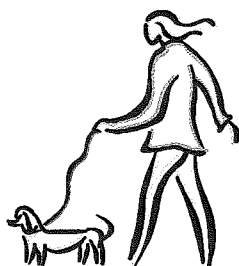

in someone's yard trash. Pet ownership comes with responsibilities and being a courteous neighbor is one of them.

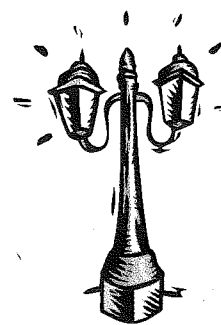


Get on the Email List
