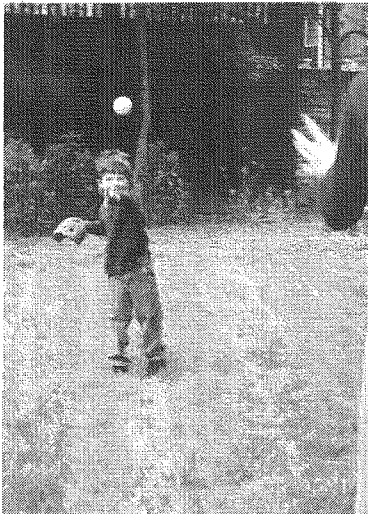

Bert and Laura Smith with daughter Georgia have moved into 80 Huntington Road.

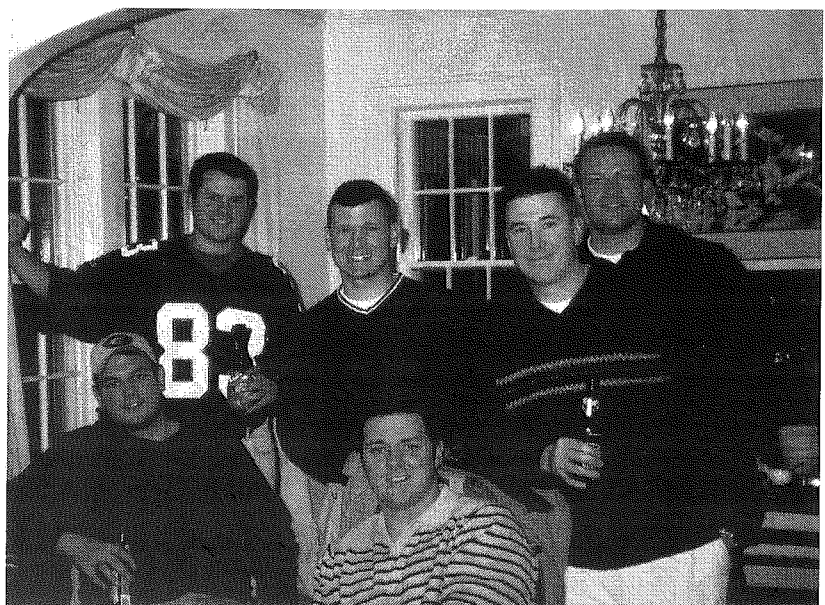
Tyler Edgarton moved into 256 Brighton Road. Tyler is in commercial real estate.

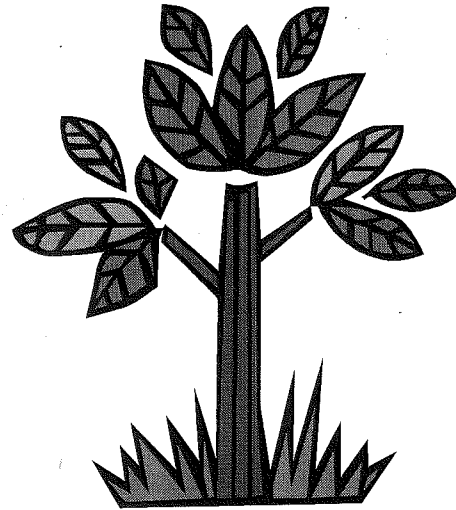
