## Brookwood Hills Tour Shows the Neighborhood at its Best!

On April 20th, Brookwood Hills hosted its fourth biennial Brookwood Hills Tour of Homes benefiting Children's Healthcare of Atlanta. The four homes featured on the tour this year wonderfully represented this year's theme, Tradition Meets Today. Thoughtful architecture and interior design have ensured that each tour home - whether two years old or nearly a century old - exuded a charming character that defines our historic neighborhood. Across the homes one could see unique interior details that respected the past while thoroughly fitting with modern life. Countless docents staffed at each house were there to welcome tour goers and provide a wealth of background information and specific home history, which was carefully researched by our own neighbor and interior designer, Caroline Tolleson.

As a neighborhood filled with the boundless energy of many little ones, we were delighted to once again give back to *Children's Healthcare of Atlanta (CHOA)*, which offers invaluable resources to the greater Atlanta community and beyond. This year the tour raised a net of \$33,191 after all expenses! This impressive number includes:

- 236 tickets sold (on top of those distributed to sponsors)
- over \$20,000.00 in sponsorships and donations
- nearly \$3,000.00 in raffle income
- \$240.00 in Generous Generations donations raised by the kids of Brookwood Hills

All agreed it was a truly enjoyable afternoon that should perhaps become a yearly event!








